#### Nut Allergy

We have children who have a severe allergy to nuts. The effect of nuts for these children can potentially be fatal. We must therefore ask you to ensure that your child does not bring anything in to school which may contain nuts, like peanut butter sandwiches but also nuts in cakes, chocolate etc.

#### Headlice
